

First Time User Registration & Daily Email Alerts

Before you begin using the CCH Online Subscriptions, its important to register as a first time user. This process will enable you to set up your username and password. As part of this process you can also choose to subscribe to the CCH Daily Email Alerts.

CCH offer a daily email service (Daily Email Alerts – DEA), which provides FREE information on key developments in your chosen field. This information comes in an article format and is a basic overview of the hot topics in your key field. They are easily digestible and easy to access. In your email, each news item is formatted with a hyperlink. You simply click on the link to read the full story.

To access these daily email alerts, you must register on the CCH Website. This information service is separate to your subscriptions and any person can register, regardless of whether they subscribe to CCH products or not.

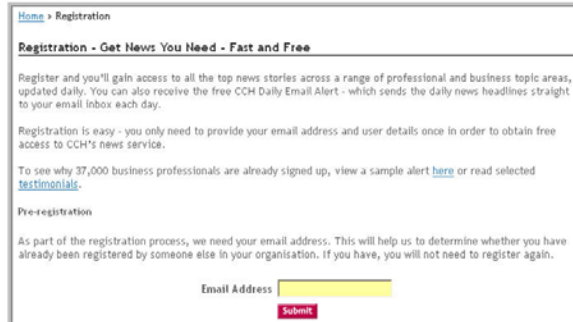
How to register

Log onto the CCH website – www.cch.com.au

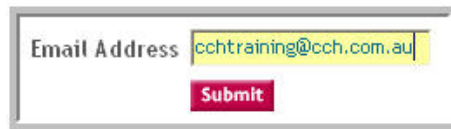


In the top right hand corner, there is a login button. Select **Free Registration**

To begin the registration process, you will need to provide a **valid email address**.

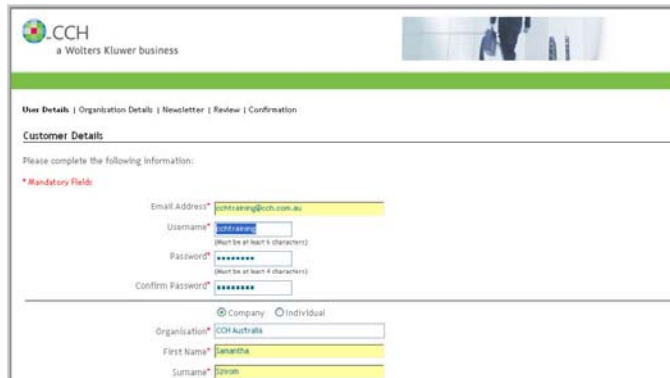


Type in your **email address** and click on **Submit**




The next step is to provide more information about yourself. The fields marked with a red asterisk are **mandatory** fields. Complete each field and click on **Next**.


Please note: You cannot provide a PO or GPO Box as the address.



The next step involves you providing information about you and your organisation. The fields marked with a red asterisk are **mandatory** fields. Select the options that are best fit to you and your organisation.




The final step is registering for **Daily Email Alerts**. If you wish to receive them, select **Yes**. Then, select the **areas of interest** for your email content, and click on **Submit**.




A Daily Email Alert will be emailed directly to your Inbox.
